Current Louisiana Data

Interesting New State Data DHH 04-08 Comparison

- Number of Treated Kids Was Static– 250,000+/-
- Number of Untreated Kids Increased
 - Over 505,000
- Dental Expenditures Doubled
- Number of Active Medicaid Dentists
 Decreased 760

Access Through The Current Dentist Workforce In LA

505,000/760 Active Dentists =
 665 NEW Patients Per Treating Doctor

What Was The Conflict?

LDA Board Was Told:

- "99% of the LDA's active, statewide membership objects to and opposes the treatment of Medicaid eligible students within Louisiana public schools"
- "Dentists across the state simply cannot compete for business where access to the entire market of Medicaid eligible students is controlled by Dr. Folse and his partner ReachOut Healthcare America

LDA Board Was Told:

- "Many of these pediatric dentists will struggle to maintain practices and will be relegated to boutique-type operations"
- "... the detrimental impact to all dentists as a whole goes beyond mere students who are Medicaid eligible. Dr. Folse and ReachOut Healthcare will eventually target all students whether Medicaid eligible or not.
- "Our years of hard work and perseverance, however, are now threatened by an out-of-state company. Now more than ever, the LDA's membership base needs LDA's help."

In Response LDA

- Convened The LDA Mobile Dentistry Task Force "...to monitor the private practice of dentistry in public schools and...develop appropriate rules to ensure maintenance of the prevailing standard for quality of care..."
- Composed Of a Few Mobile Dentistry
 Friendly Participants
- At Their Only Meeting The Only Issue
 Presented Was To Pass A Resolution
 Against Mobile Dentistry

In Response LDA

- Resolved, The LDA Supports The Dental Home Concept....
 - 3)In A Permanently Established Facility
- Opposes Any Means Of Delivering Dental
 Care That Compromises Those Standards
 Including The Practice Of Dentistry On The
 Grounds Of Public Schools

In Response LDA

- Pro-School Based Task Force Members
 Were Dismissed
- Members Changed To Anti-School-Based Members and Task Force Renamed The "Access To Care Task Force" (ATCTF)
- Resolution Passed By The HOD
- Bill Introduced Into Legislature By ATCTF
- OATCTF Directed All Talking Points From Then On Not The LDA and Not The Council On Governmental Affairs

HB 687

- "Prohibits Practice Of Dentistry In Schools"
- Grounds Of Any Elementary Or Secondary School Within The State Of Louisiana Is Prohibited"
- Overview
 - Pulling Teeth In A School Library Or Gym and Performing Invasive Procedures Without Parental Supervision....

HB 687

- Became a Bill Forcing State Board To Enact Regulations On Mobile Dentistry
- State Board Strongly Lobbied To Regulate Mobile Dentistry Out
